



PRNA Representative Teams

Each year Pine Rivers Netball fields Association teams across a range of age divisions: 12 years to Open. These teams represent Pine Rivers in all Netball Queensland competitions and other local Association Carnivals.

Our Representative Team structure provides a development pathway for players wishing to advance their skills and who aim for further Regional, State or National representative goals.

Being a member of a Pine Rivers Netball Association team can be a very rewarding and enjoyable experience. Not only will you benefit from the expert coaching you receive under our team of Rep. Coaches, but you also have the opportunity to travel with friends and compete against teams from across Queensland!

How do I become involved?

Player nominations close at the end of January each year. A number of selection trials and squad training sessions are then staged during February. It is here that your skills, ability level, teamwork and commitment are assessed by our Selection Committee. Representative teams (normally two teams per age division of 9 players each) are announced by the end of February. To nominate you only need to complete and return the official PRNA Player Representative Nomination form and submit this, via your own club, to PRNA. You must also be a registered player who intends playing in PRNA's 2009 Winter Season fixtures.

Responsibilities & Commitments

Being a member of a PRNA Representative Team is an excellent achievement in any Players' career. However, along with the achievement comes a number of responsibilities. It requires commitment to attend all training sessions and team competitions across the entire season (March - September). It requires dedication in respect to your fitness and skill training... you need to continually put in and work hard to ensure ongoing development. Finally, you need to be a team player and have the personal qualities that ensure you work well within a team environment. Fun, Fitness, Fundamentals, Friendship, Commitment and drive to achieve.....are the keys!

Part of PRNA's Team Selection procedures will require all selected players, and their parents, to 'sign-off' and confirm their commitment and ability to meet all team responsibilities, competition dates and payment of fees. While full details are available from PRNA's Secretary, in general commitments include:-

- Representing PRNA proudly at all times;
- Abiding by PRNA's Codes of Conduct;
- Working harmoniously with all team members, coaches and supporting officials, at all times;
- Be available and attend all team training sessions. This means arriving on time, attending even when you may be injured or sick to observe, and being dressed & prepared for full active participation at all times;
- Be available to attend all team competitions. When a team travels all players must travel together as a team and if overnight accommodation is required teams will stay together as a team.
