



## HOW TO SCORE – A QUICK GUIDE – 2010 SEASON

The most common way to assist your child's team is through scoring at games. A lot of people tend to shy away from scoring as they do not know how to score. This quick guide is designed to assist you and others understand how scoring works.

At each game, there needs to be 2 scorers (1 for each team playing). One scorer will watch and communicate to the marking scorer on the goals attempted and scored as well as centre passes. These roles can be switched at half time. Please note: If the other team does not provide a scorer, they cannot contest the score at the end of the game.

On the third page of this section, there contains an example score sheet (these are collected from Control before the game) which is marked out with areas of importance. These are as follows:

**SECTION A:** This section needs to be completed by the winning team scorer at the end of the game. The final score should show the score of the team on the left hand side first then the score for the team on the right hand side (i.e. 0 – 4) meaning that in the score for the example score sheet was Ace = 0 and Scorpions = 4.

**SECTION B:** The positions section does **not need to be completed** this is a Netball Queensland option.

**SECTION C:** This is the area where both teams sign their signature as it has been signed on the yellow registration card at the first game of the season. The players names will automatically appear. **Point penalties apply if this is not completed correctly.**

### **Important Notes:**

1. **If there are less than 7 players taking the court, the number of players needs to be written on the form, otherwise penalties apply. A team cannot take the court with less than 5 players.**
2. **If a player is playing up for a team (from a lower division only, it cannot be a player from another team within the same division), then this player and the team they are playing up from, needs to be shown on the score sheet. Point penalties apply if this is not completed correctly**

**SECTION D:** Before the game commences, both teams will toss a coin to determine who will take the first centre pass. Each team then alternates centre passes throughout the game.

It is the scorer's responsibility to maintain an ongoing record of when each team has the centre pass as the umpires may request the scorer to advise them of who gets centre pass at the beginning of the next quarter. **(Note: Umpires have the final decision on centre pass)**

**SECTION E:** This is where for each team playing, if Goal Shooter (GS) or Goal Attack (GA) attempts at goal, the result is marked. If either GS or GA misses the goal then an “O” is marked in the box, if either GS or GA convert the goal successfully then an “X” is marked in the box. Counting the X’s at the end of each quarter, is a useful way to reconcile the goal count to what goals have been crossed off. **See Section F.**

**SECTION F:** This is where successful goals are marked off for each team as they occur throughout each quarter. Again this is useful to reconcile back to the Goal Attempts in Section E.

**SECTION G:** At the end of the game, the umpires, scorers and captains from each team must sign the score sheet. Please note: The winning team is responsible for returning the score sheet to control.
